O'Melveny reported increased revenue in 2019 for the fifth year in a row, *The American Lawyer* wrote.

"The firm's net income rose 4.9% to \$396.1 million, a 47% hike over the last five years. Profits per equity partner climbed 2.4% to \$2.32 million, while revenue per lawyer expanded by 5.2% to \$1.25 million," the article noted. O'Melveny Chairman Bradley Butwin told the publication that 2019 saw "a broad amount of above-the-fold work." *AmLaw* cited in particular "two significant trial efforts."

"In February, a federal appeals court affirmed its victory on behalf of AT&T and Time Warner, which sought to preserve their \$100 billion merger against opposition from the U.S. Department of Justice," *AmLaw* noted. "Then, in May, serving as J&J's national litigation counsel, the firm took the country's first opioid case to trial, where it limited Oklahoma to 2.6% of the \$17.7 billion it had sought."
