Partner Sabrina Strong appeared on NBC's "The Today Show" to talk about the expected decision in a closely-watched Oklahoma trial, which will determine whether Johnson & Johnson should be held liable for the state's opioid crisis.

Johnson & Johnson "brought essential medicines to people who suffer from debilitating chronic pain," Strong said. "What the evidence showed at trial, is that the company did absolutely nothing wrong. The facts are that the company's products were rarely diverted, rarely abused, and amount to less than one percent of all the opioid medicines that are prescribed to patients in Oklahoma."
