In that role, Julia provided oversight across a broad range of civil enforcement matters, including Bayer's US\$66 billion acquisition of Monsanto, in which the Division obtained a comprehensive US\$9 billion divestiture, and the Division's successful challenge to the merger of Novelis and Aleris, which was its first use of arbitration to resolve a merger challenge.

Brinkley Tappan is Assistant Vice President and Senior Counsel for Antitrust at AT&T. Prior to joining AT&T in 2018, Brinkley served as Counsel to the Assistant Attorney General at the Antitrust Division of the U.S. Department of Justice. While at DOJ, she advised Division and other DOJ officials on merger and conduct matters under investigation, negotiated consent and plea agreements, and assisted on formulating policy positions and public statements.
