## Reynolds, Orr Draft Article on California's New Draft Autonomous Vehicle Regulations

O'Melveny's Michael Reynolds and Jason Orr co-authored the article "California Revises Draft Autonomous Vehicle Regulations" in the October 11, 2016, edition of *Law360*. The authors detail the California Department of Motor Vehicles' revised draft of regulations that could "open the doors to the widespread deployment of driverless vehicles — with no steering wheel, accelerator, or brake pedal — on public roads."

According to the authors, "The new draft regulations are generally more permissive than those in the previous draft. California is a focal point for the development and testing of autonomous vehicle technologies and one of the largest potential markets for autonomous vehicles."
